SESSION DIGEST, OCTOBER 12, 2015

The Session was moderated by Reverend Dale Walker (Salem Presbytery's liaison to Covenant, and Covenant's appointed moderator in the absence of a pastor) at its October stated meeting. Dale led the group in a responsive reading focused on our human hopes and limitations.

Session actions:

- Reviewed ordination/installation vows for Ruling Elders. The current form is not in line with the PCUSA requirements in the Book of Order. A motion was made and approved to ask Dale to re-write some of the questions, merging a Progressive Christianity approach with the original required vows, and to ask Salem Presbytery's Committee on Ministry for approval.
- Re-visited the idea of hiring a short-term or bridge interim pastor. A
 motion was made to interview a candidate available only until January
 1, 2016. Motion failed. (Normally, an interim is contracted for at least
 one year.)
- Accepted gladly the offer by the team of Julie Strope and Joyce Powers to organize and serve the annual Stewardship luncheon on November 1st.
- Heard pastoral care issues. Confirmed that Chipper Nuckles will be "on-call" for the congregation during the week but unavailable on Sundays as he has been hired as stated supply in High Point.
- Approved the motion of the Nominating Committee to hold two congregational meetings: October 25th for the purpose of electing three members from the congregation to serve on the nominating committee; and November 15th to vote on a proposed slate of elders for the Class of 2018.
- Heard monthly committee reports.
- Approved expenditures for technical support and upgrades to the church's website and for improvements to the pastor's office.
- Received a revised "Time and Talents Form" to be sent with the annual stewardship letter.

Ended with prayer.
